Admission Requirements for Masters Programmes:

- *First Class Honours or Second Class Honours, Upper Division from any Recognized University.*
- *Second Class Lower Division from any recognized University with at least Two (2) years experience in Research, Administration, Management or the public sector, as evidenced by at least one published paper in a refereed Journal or Technical reports and patent documents.*

Doctor of Philosophy in Management and Leadership (PhD)

The Doctor of Philosophy in Management and Leadership is an inter-disciplinary programme designed for those who intend to advance their careers, to more complex leadership positions in both industry and academia.

Minimum requirements for PhD Programme:

- *Master Degree in Management and Leadership or Business Administration and a Bachelor Degree.*
- *Relevant master degree or other equivalent qualifications acceptable by MUA Senate.*

Admission Requirements for Undergraduates Programmes

1. **KCSE** - Mean Grade C+ with C plain in both Mathematics and English or Kiswahili; Mean Grade C or its equivalent with a diploma in the relevant area of study from a recognized institution.
2. **IGCSE** - 5 Upper levels passes (equivalent to C+)
3. **GCE** - Five (5), O' Level (equivalent to C+) with a pass, C in Maths & English or Kiswahili
4. **12th GRADE GPA of 2.5 or above**
5. **KACE** - 2 Principal passes & minimum pass of 7 in Maths & English or Kiswahili at KCE.
6. **Diploma or above.**
