1.0 SENIOR LECTURERS – TWO POSITIONS

Applicants must be holders of a PhD degree in Education Arts, specializing in Religious Studies, Kiswahili, History or Geography.

- e) Must have supervised three (3) post graduate students to completion as a Lecturer or equivalent.
- f) Must have been an academic leader in a University for a minimum of two (2) years
